## Twelfth Grade – How to Build Community

For the final three sessions of your student's senior year, we highly recommend that you use your sessions to do one of two things (or both)! One, have a panel of leaders, pastors, or even some older students who have done college or early adulthood well, and allow students to anonymously write in questions for them! Q&A is a great way to answer exactly what students are asking, and help alleviate anxieties as they move into the next phase of life. The second idea, is to have a few leaders share their personal stories of friendships and advice on community building learned from their own life and walk with God and His people. Since how to build community is so influenced by our cultural moment, we have seen that formats like these work better than a more traditional Bible study to equip students for the next season!
