Easter Tic-Tac-Toe

OVERVIEW

As a spin to this classic game, players will compete in a head-to-head match, attempting to toss plastic eggs into glasses of water until they get 3 in a row.

- Plastic Easter eggs (at least 24 in two distinct colors)
- A bucket
- 9 cups filled with water
- Table for glasses of water
- Masking tape

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

HOW-TO

PREP

- Purchase plastic Easter eggs.
- Add plastic Easter eggs to the bucket.
- Set up 9 cups filled with water and arrange them into a 3 x 3 tic-tac-toe grid.
- Determine how far back players will throw the eggs (we recommend that players are at least 6 feet away from the "tic-tac-toe" board).
- Use the masking tape on the ground to mark the play space as well as the throwing distance.

PLAY

Have two players come to the play area. Each player is then given a bucket of Easter eggs. Then each player will stand a distance away (at least six-feet) from the tic-tac-toe grid of 9 glasses of water and they will take turns tossing their eggs into the glasses of water, trying to get three in a row. The first player to get three in a row wins the game!

Optionally, you can play with teams of at least 3 with players from each team rotating after they throw an egg.
