### **OVERVIEW**

Players' knowledge of the past will be tested to see if they can match which two items made their debuts in the same year.

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

A list containing pairs of pop culture events or releases that occured in the same year

## HOW-TO

#### PREP

- Gather multiple popular events/songs/movies that happened in different years (or use the examples provided).
- Determine if you will play on teams or as individuals.

#### PLAY

In this game, teams (or individuals) will be read a sentence containing two pop culture references. Players will decide which year those events occured. Once they hear the sentence, they have to decide what year in which those things happened. The team or individual to answer fastest gets a point. For every wrong guess, they lose a point. The team or player with the most points wins!

### **Examples:**

"The same year the Avengers faced Ultron, Shawn Mendes decided to sing about stitches. What year is it?" (Year: 2015) "A group of heroes protected the galaxy from a blue guy and you heard the song "Happy" everywhere you went. What year is it?" (Year: 2014)

"Black Panther and Wakanda dominated the movies and Drake decided to play Fortnite. What year is it?" (Year: 2018) "A small town called Riverdale caught everyone's attention, while Taylor Swift released her reputation." (Year: 2017)

"People couldn't agree on the color of a dress, while One Direction went in separate directions." (Year: 2015)

"Kanye West debuted his Sunday Service at Coachella, while everything on TikTok was renegade." (Year: 2019)

"Country and hip-hop fused together with the git up challenge and Lil Nas X putting out a hit about an old town road." (Year: 2019)

"While everyone was outside trying to catch 'em all, the Chicago Cubs finally won the World Series Championship." (Year: 2016)

"While Kristen Stewart's twilight came to an end, Jennifer Lawrence volunteered as tribute." (Year: 2012)
